*The Johannesburg Zoo invites tenderers locally and abroad for the manufacture, supply and installation of Acrylic panels for the temple of the Ancient Exhibit in its facilities in Parkview (Johannesburg, South Africa).*

## STRATEGIC THRUST

One of the Joburg zoo's most important goals is the periodic provision of new and interesting exhibits in order to encourage visits from new customers as well as repeat visits by previous ones. In keeping with this goal we are currently completing the building of the new "Temple of the ancients" exhibit. I would like to complete any outstanding work as soon as possible in order to facilitate the opening of the new exhibit.

## BACKGROUND

Acrylic viewing panels form an integral part of the aquatic exhibits in the Temple of the ancients as they provide a window through which the visitor can look into the exhibit below water level.

The Temple exhibit building has been completed but before the exhibit can be commissioned the aquariums need to be completed. The installation of an acrylic tunnel and two porthole bubbles in the large exhibit as well as the curved panels of the large cylinder still need to be accomplished. Custom acrylic panel manufacture and installation is a much specialised job which needs to be carried out by contractors who have the relevant experience with this material.
